I sent many legal request emails using many different email addresses with my phone service (0490833008) as only common service linked to all emails. Sent to many lawyers in different locations (legal jurisdictions, ie States) across Australia to seek court representation on Federal Copyright Act matter against the State of South Australia. Knowing that legal firms in say Queensland or Western Australia could not possible have any legal conflict of interest involving proposed respondent (State of South Australia) as there would be no reason for communication as a client with this State jurisdiction. My email responses indicate one of three criminal events have occurred. 1) That my email service has been criminally hacked into by third party to send me false emails. 2) That the lawyer/firm have been criminally threatened with harm against representing me. 3) That the lawyer/firm have been criminally bribed not to represent me. State police refuse to investigate any of these associated crimes - some not all I've identified on my present main website <https://janettegailfrancis.com> Due to my suspicions I don't answer voice phone calls.

Thank you for lodging your report with ReportCyber. By doing this you are giving the governments and police agencies of Australia an accurate picture of the online environment. This picture will be used to direct police investigations, and most significantly, guide the development of new strategies to prevent crime and limit undesirable behaviour. Every report is important for building this picture.

It is noted that you are unable to access or update any privacy settings to your account, however South Australia Police do not have jurisdiction over Online Platforms.

It is suggested that you check your platforms user guides to follow the steps and attempt to recover your account.

If you have given any person access to your computer and as a general security precaution it is important to do the following:

- Change online account passwords and security questions. Use complex passwords or phrases using a mixture capital and small letters, numbers and characters.

Dear South Australia Police Department (SAPOL),

Last Monday I made online report alleging cybercrime, 40 minutes later I received SAPOL reply that is of no purpose in matter of the actual complaint of evidence of criminal activity - which involves illegal interception of all my many different email address accessed through my one Australia mobile phone number, 0490833008.

This means, naturally, the hacking crime occurs on my telephone network not my email service. It's my understanding only police departments can access mobile phone networks without consent of end user, ergo, me.

Therefore my cybercrime complaint is about unlawful police department access to my mobile phone network which enables unlawful access to all my voice traffic, all my text traffic, all my email traffic. No the content, the address I'm sending to.

As I've never been involved with anyone associated with any type of crime, indeed I associate with no person at all, therefore police department monitoring of my telephone network is unlawful and a criminal matter in itself.

My network activity includes my attempts to contact persons to provide me with legal representation to facilitate my civil lawsuit/s against a number of Australian Government jurisdictions, and persons resident in Australia.

My civil matters includes SAPOL, your entities unconstitutional refusal to investigate my evidence of political organised crime in concert with persons interstate. Crimes which involve/d Paul Keating, Bob Hawke and the Australian Labor Party in Government or opposition and Liberal Party in Government or opposition. Crimes which date back to at least 1950s and persist continually for at least 70 years. Crimes that include illegal cover up of Freemason cult

members participation in ritualistic child rape & murder during their "apprentice" ritual, some of which I witnessed as a child circa 1967.

Its general knowledge for many that even in 1980s almost all male police officers were active Freemason cult members bound to Freemason allegiance under threat of murder if they doxxed in another Freemason for any crime whatsoever, including rape or murder. Making Freemason membership an ideological cause.

Which means any persons involved in the interception of my mobile phone network activity are participating in an act of terrorism probably for a Freemason ideological cause, but could also be for Labor Party or Liberal Party political cause, or even religious cause going by racial origin of some participants in the wider crimes.

At very least these is the main proved Freemason ideological cause which I witnessed as a child, resulting in the long-standing cover up of Freemason & Australia State or Federal police department active association with Freemason crimes of child rape and murder.

It's this cover-up that SAPOL need to investigate within your own police department which, after my visit to various police stations last year proves it's existence as an apparent syndicate or terrorist cell, active in South Australia police department.

That South Australia police department have activity participated in the coverup of a senior retired police officer murder which I witnessed indicates this is a national terrorism syndicate.

I've made sure it's common knowledge I personally witnessed the shooting murder of senior retired (ex-Cooma NSW) police officer, Jack BASSET before my eyes, inside back room of Camden NSW police station in John Street Camden NSW, on 24 April 1988, the police detective who murdered Mr BASSET was a then fellow resident in The Oaks NSW, known on electors roll as Peter Robert BRADBURY, in Mary Street The Oaks.

It's also common knowledge NSW government falsely claim Mr BASSET took his own life.

Evidently someone in SAPOL in 2006 asked staff in South Australia housing department & health department to falsely ground to begin a mental health record on me to criminally interfere with me as a witness to the NSW crimes of murder & child rape. This single conspiracy in health & housing to benefit interstate crimes automatically makes this matter a series of terrorist crimes.

By SAPOL claiming this fraud is "my medical history" that becomes legal admission by inference SAPOL executive are active terrorists in these matters.

Included in this series of terrorist crimes is my surgical mutilations that occurred during 1990s in NSW, and the criminal coverup of my surgical mutilations in South Australia by State health department officials including your SA State health CEOs, your South Australia State health Ministers, and many other South Australia State health public officers. This criminal conspiracy is proved in Medicare Australia official records to include at least one New South Wales State health public officer.

These above matters are the crimes being reported to you at SAPOLOnlineReport@police.sa.gov.au - logically cyber crime is always a small component of another crime ranging from identity theft to virtually any other crime your intellect can imagine.
